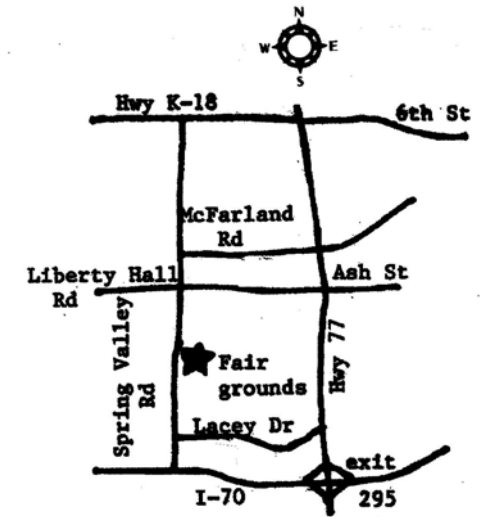

2017 SPECIAL BAKING CONTEST

Homemade Oatmeal Cookies

- Judging Wednesday, July 26 @ 5:30 pm
- Enter between 4:30 and 5:30 pm
- Entry is to consist of six oatmeal cookies of uniform size
- All cookies should be from the same recipe
- Entry must be prepared from scratch and baked by the person whose name is on the entry form
- Commercial mixes and no-bake cookies are NOT allowed
- Cookies cannot have icing or decorations
- Recipe must accompany entry and must include a list of all ingredients, quantities, preparation instructions, and should NOT contain the name of the baker
- Recipes will be returned to the contestant after the contest
- Entry must be displayed on stiff, foil-covered cardboard, and enclosed in a sealable food-grade plastic bag
- Cookies will be judged on taste and appearance
- There is no limit on number of entries per person, but the recipes must be considerably different for each entry
- Contest open to youth and adults and will be judged in two divisions: youth (age 4-18) and adult
- Prizes awarded for the top 3 places in each division
