Fair Pre-entry

Don't forget that fair pre-entry forms are due to the Extension Office by 5:00pm on Friday, June 30th. No late entries will be accepted.

Fair Superintendents Meeting/Clean-Up & Set-up

There will be a meeting for all fair superintendents on Sunday, July 23rd at 1:00pm at the Fairgrounds. If you are a superintendent, please plan to attend. All 4-H families should plan to attend fair clean-up and set-up on Sunday, July 23rd at 1:30pm at the Fairgrounds. Bring along rakes, shovels, old rags, and buckets to help with the cleaning. Clean-up/Set-up will count towards the Herdsman Award again this year!

Herdsman Award

Geary County Farm Bureau has generously volunteered to sponsor \$100 for the winner of the Herdsman Award this year. The Herdsman Trophy will be presented to the club who keeps their areas in the livestock barn the cleanest and neatest. In addition, part of the award will be based on each club's percentage of participation in pre-fair clean-up/set-up. Don't forget to sign in if you help with this so that you can get credit. See the fair book for more information.

Fair Books

All fair books should have been distributed via club meetings, pick-up, or mail. If you have not received a fair book, please call the Extension Office and make arrangements to pick one up or have it mailed to you. The book and easy form-fillable pre-entry forms are all available on the web located at <http://www.geary.k-state.edu/4-h/fair.html>.

Fair Livestock Insurance

A fee of \$5 per head for market beef, market lambs, market hogs, and market goats will be required at the time of fair pre-entry to purchase livestock insurance. This insurance will cover livestock from the time you leave home for the fair until you return home or the livestock changes ownership. The insurance is optional for breeding beef and breeding sheep. Please plan to pay this fee when you turn in your pre-entry forms.

Fair Auction Requirement

Don't forget that in order to sell a project item or animal in the fair auction, a 4-H member must attend at least three club meetings during the 4-H year (started in October). The official record of meetings attended will be the club secretary's book, so make sure you get counted for the meetings that you attend.

Exhibitor Numbers

Contained with this newsletter is a list of exhibitor numbers. 4-H members are asked to please record your exhibitor number on the top right corner of each entry card that you submit. This will help the Extension staff when we record all of the ribbons that each 4-H member is awarded. Please help us out and put your number on all of your entry cards.

After-Fair Family Celebration

4-H Council has decided to have an After-Fair Family Celebration again this year. This event will be held on Friday, July 28th at the city pool from 7:15 to 9:00pm and will include swimming and snacks. Please plan to attend and celebrate the end of fair!

Fair Poultry Testing

Poultry testing for Pullorum-Typhoid and Avian Influenza will be held on Wednesday, July 5th at the Fairgrounds from 5:00-6:00pm. All chickens and turkeys going to fair must be tested. If you do not attend this testing, you are responsible for getting your birds tested and showing proof of testing when birds are brought to the fair (alternate testing dates from surrounding counties may be available by calling the Extension Office). There is no cost for this testing.

Judging Contest Help Needed

Adults and older youth are needed to help with the Horticulture and Photography Judging contests on Wednesday, July 26th from 10:00am to noon. Those who volunteer will be assisting with conducting the contests by helping youth sign-up and begin judging, reading for youth who need assistance, answering questions, and making sure that no cheating occurs. If you can help, contact the Extension Office.

Dogs on Fairgrounds

Fair Board has ruled that no dogs will be allowed on the fairgrounds during the Geary County Free Fair, July 23-27. Thanks for abiding by this rule!
