State Livestock
Nomination Process
for Kansas State Fair &
Kansas Junior
Livestock Show

The state livestock nomination season is rapidly approaching and will continue to be an online process. It is going to be **IMPERATIVE** for you to plan ahead this year. You will not be able to wait until the last minute and successfully complete the process. Market Beef nominations will be due on May 1. All other species, which includes commercial heifers, market swine, commercial gilts, market lambs, commercial ewes, and ALL meat goats, will be due June 15. You will need to order nomination DNA envelopes at least 10 days ahead of these deadlines. Kansas State University Animal Sciences Leadership Academy (KASLA) Applications are due by April 15 for KASLA. Hosted by the K-State Department of Animal Sciences and Industry and sponsored by the Livestock and Meat Industry Council Inc., the academy is an intensive four-day educational experience designed to enhance the leadership skills and animal science knowledge of students in grades 9-12. The program's itinerary will feature interactive workshops, tours, and mentor time with department faculty. KASLA will be held June 21-24, 2023. Requirement for 2023

4-H members will be required to <u>attend in-person at least 4 regular monthly</u> meetings of the 4-H club in which they are enrolled between October 1 and June <u>30</u> to participate in the project/livestock auction held at the end of the fair in 2023. Official record of meetings attended will be the club secretary's book. This requirement does not limit fair participation, only participation in the auction. Plan ahead now to make sure youth meet the requirement if they want to participate in the auction.
