Texture

Texture is the surface quality of an item; it's how something feels when touched or looks like it would feel, if touched

Texture adds interest to art projects and makes them look more realistic

In drawing and painting, short lines can indicate texture better than continuous solid lines

Texture Treasure Hunt

- Print the Texture Treasure Hunt paper from https://www.geary.k-state.edu/4-h/virtual_visual_arts_lessons.html
- Look around and you'll recognize items that are bumpy, smooth, spiky, scaly, fluffy, etc.
- Place the paper on top of different textures and use crayons to create a rubbing in the individual spaces
 - Use just one color or change colors with each section
